Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs related to federal courts and tribunals, family law, alternative dispute resolution, intercountry adoption, and administrative law and civil procedure

Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs related to human rights, Indigenous law and justice, legal assistance and native title

Responsible for: Policy, legislation and advice on Australian Government legal services, bankruptcy and personal insolvency, copyright, classification and international legal services; classification operations; reform of Australian personal property securities law and regulation of the national legal profession; and support for the Attorney-General in the performance of his First Law Officer role

Responsible for: Policy, legislation and advice to support the Commonwealth's interests in Australia's Territories. Provision of state-type services to residents of Australia's non-self-governing and external territories.

Responsible for: Drafting of legislative and other instruments, maintenance of the Federal Register of Legislative Instruments, publication of legislative materials, and related legal services

Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs related to international law

Responsible for: Strategic policy and law reform, portfolio coordination, constitutional law, cabinet and ministerial coordination and public affairs

Responsible for: Financial planning and management, portfolio budget statements, compliance and risk management and property management

Responsible for: Human resources, governance, property support services, information communications technology, information management, the Departmental Security Unit and secure services such as the Australian Secure Network

Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs related to developing resilience to all hazards, including the areas of critical infrastructure protection, chemical, electronic and identity security, and protective security policy

Responsible for: Operational coordination of responses to all hazards, including natural disasters, terrorism and pandemics. Also incorporates the national security hotline, disaster relief, dignitary protection and protective security

Responsible for: Developing national security capability; coordinating procedures, training, exercises, evaluation, procurement and R&D for all-hazards; managing the National Counter-Terrorism Committee Administered Fund; delivering training and education; administering grants to volunteer organisations and for disaster mitigation

Responsible for: Policy, legislation and advice on national security, counter-terrorism, surveillance devices, tele-communications interception and for delivery of vetting and background checking services which incorporates AusCheck and the Australian Security Vetting Service

Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs related to criminal law, criminal justice processes, operational law enforcement, border management and crime prevention, including liaison with AFP, Customs and ACC.

Responsible for: Policy, legislation, advice and programs on international criminal justice issues
